



It is recommended that one uses the roads in black to reach the Exeter Inn.

From Eggesford take the A377 toward Barnstaple. At Kings Nympton station, turn right onto the B3226 toward South Molton. Shortly after crossing over the river Mole, turn left signposted to Chittlehamholt.

From Barnstaple and Atherington turn left over the river Taw towards South Molton on the B3227. Immediately on the far side of the bridge turn right towards Warkleigh. At the cross roads at the top of the hill, turn right to Chittlehamholt.

From South Molton, take the B2336 toward Chulmleigh. About 2 miles after Clapworthy, turn right signposted Chittlehamholt together with a big sign for the Exeter Inn. Turn left at the T junction at the top of the hill. Alternatively, take the B3227 toward Umberleigh. Turn left opposite the third road leading to Chittlehampton with the sign to Chillehamholt.

If you have elected to come from the West to meet the A377 at Kingford, the road to Chillehamholt is a few yards towards Portsmouth Arms on the left. Note that this road is quite narrow and has many sharp bends. It is not called Snake Lane for nothing. The road bears left at the top for the centre of Chittlehamholt.
